UNDERWATER HERITAGE ORDER

made by the Commissioners of Public Works in Ireland pursuant to Section 3(1), National Monuments (Amendment) Act, 1987

WHEREAS

The Commissioners of Public Works in Ireland (hereinafter referred to as "the Commissioners") are satisfied in respect of Lough Donogher and the land covered by water forming the bed of that Lake (a territorial water of the State) in County Leitrim delineated on the Map hereunto annexed and thereon bounded by a red verge line that:

- (a) it is or may prove to be a site where a wreck or an archaeological object lies or formerly lay, and
- (b) on account of the historical, archaeological or artistic importance of the wreck or the object the site ought to be protected.

NOW THEREFORE the Commissioners in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Section 3(1), National Monuments (Amendment) Act, 1987 do hereby ORDER AND DECLARE that Lough Donogher together with the land covered by water forming part of the bed of that Lake in the townlands of Aghalough, Lavareen and Derrindrehid in County Leitrim delineated on the Ordnance Survey Map hereunto annexed and thereon bounded by a red verge line shall, as and from the date hereof, be deemed to be and is hereby designated a "restricted area" within the meaning of that term in the said Act.
